## Responding to Gender-based Violence Wangu Kanja and The Ruben Centre – Worksheet

Wangu Kanja is a Kenyan woman and a survivor of a gender-based violence crime in 2002. Wangu was unable to access any support services at that time, so she started her own foundation, the [Wangu Kanja Foundation](#) to provide a broad range of research, support and advocacy services to survivors of GBV. The Wangu Kanja Foundation operates out of the [Ruben Centre](#) which is part of the Mukuru township (sometimes referred to as the Mukuru slum) in Nairobi, Kenya.
